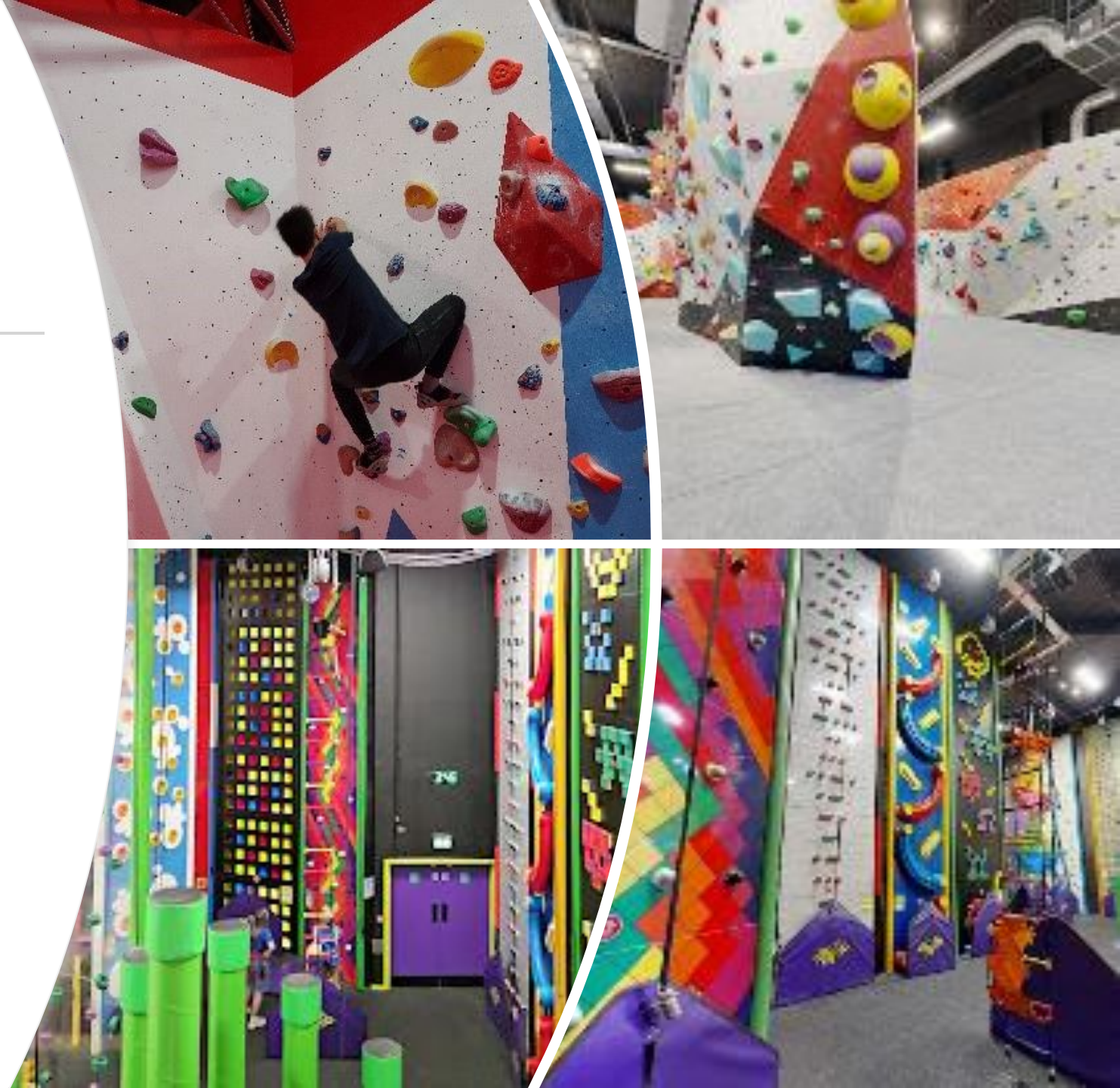
# Sailing/Paddle boarding– Year 7

For the Bronze award students have to complete a 2 day expedition with 1 night camping.

They started from Belton in Rutland and navigated their way to Wing where they set up camp and cooked their evening meal. They reviewed how the day went and discussed as a team areas they needed to work on the following day such as navigation, timing, organisation. The second day they navigated themselves to the finish which was at Rutland water in Edith Weston. They will be able to sign up for this amazing award
