How students will be assessed:	<p>Paper 2 Section A: Modern text – <i>An Inspector Calls</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students respond to ONE question from a choice of TWO. • The question will be about <i>either</i> characters and relationships <i>OR</i> themes and ideas presented by the writer. • Students will be expected to plan and write a response that has 4 main points or paragraphs and considers the text overall – a holistic response. • The assessment will be in class, and they will have 1 hour to complete the literature question. • Every point must include quotations from the text to support their response to task and text (A01); analysis of form, language and structure – 2 layers of analysis is suggested (A02); consideration of writer’s themes, ideas and the main intention of the writer (A03).
