How students will be assessed:	<p>Students in year 10 will sit three full papers 1: Non-Calculator Paper A and then 2 Calculator Papers, Paper B and Paper C. Each paper is 90 minutes long. This is the full GCSE content.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Content from any part of the specification may be assessed</li> <li>• A mix of question styles, from short, single-mark questions to multi-step problems. The mathematical demand increases as a student progresses through the paper.</li> <li>• Students have a topic list with Sparx codes for independent learning and a revision booklet to do over half term based on topics on Paper A.</li> </ul> <p>Sets 1 will all do Higher. Sets 3,4 and 5 will all do Foundation. Sets 2 have a combination of Higher and Foundation.</p>
